Celebrate Black Music Month At Percussion Workshop

St. Louis County Library celebrates Black Music Month with a Children's Percussion Workshop presented by "Papa" and Jackie Wright on Tuesday, June 26, at 10 a.m. at Library Headquarters, 1640 S. Lindbergh Blvd. The program is for all ages, and it is free and open to the public.

Young people will be introduced to the percussion family of instruments in a fun and entertaining way. Through hands on participation, they will learn to identify various instruments, perform simple rhythms and melodies, and learn how percussion instruments can be used as sound effects. Participants will be given the opportunity to express themselves creatively while learning teamwork and group participation skills.
