Indian Trails Branch opened its doors on July 20, 1987. It replaced the Eliza Heidbrink Branch, which was the second branch to open in the St. Louis County Library District. The Indian Trails Branch was built to serve an area of the St. Louis County bounded by St. Charles Rock Road on the north and Page Avenue on the south. That area includes the municipalities of Charlack, Overland, Breckenridge Hills, St. John, Vinita Terrace, Vinita Park, Pagedale and Hanley Hills. The Indian Trails Branch is located on 1.5 acres at 8400 Delport Drive in Vinita Park.
