Inspirational Fiction Author Pat Simmons at Lewis and Clark Branch

The St. Louis County Library Foundation presents author Pat Simmons who will discuss her latest book, "Guilty of Love," Monday, Sept. 17, at 7 p.m. at the Lewis and Clark Branch, 9909 Lewis and Clark Blvd. The program is free and open to the public. A book signing will follow the program. Books for signing will be available at the event.

Simmons is a Christian romance fiction author. Her latest novel, "Guilty of Love," follows the adventures of Cheney Reynolds. After a traumatic experience, Cheney retreats from the world inside a dilapidated historic home. It takes a surprising friendship with a nosy neighbor and unexpected romantic encounter for Cheney to discover a second chance at happiness.

Simmon's fiction has previously appeared in an anthology edited with Parry Brown, "Love is Blind." For the past eight years, she has been a television news writer and assignment editor in Missouri. Prior to that, for 10 years she worked as a talk show host, and news reporter for various radio stations. Simmons is the co-publicist at Midwest Publicity, a two-woman team, handling the media publicity for the Romantic Times BOOKlovers' yearly conventions, and securing interviews for national bestselling authors such as L.A. Banks, Bobbi Smith, Christina Skye, and Heather Graham.
