International Bestselling Romance Writer Barbara Taylor Bradford Visits County Library

The St. Louis County Library Foundation is pleased to present Barbara Taylor Bradford, one of the world's top romance fiction writers, for a reading and signing of her latest novel "The Heir" on Monday, November 19, at 7:00 p.m. at Library Headquarters, 1640 S. Lindbergh Blvd.

The program is free and open to the public. Doors will open at 6:00 p.m. Left Bank Books will provide copies of Ms. Bradford's books for purchase at the program.

Barbara Taylor Bradford's first novel "A Woman of Substance" was an international bestseller and remains one of the top ten bestselling romance books of all time. Bradford has followed up on this success with a string of twenty "New York Times" bestselling novels. Her work has been published in more than 90 countries in 40 languages, and total sales of her books now surpass 75 million copies.

Ms. Bradford's newest novel, "The Heir," is the second installment in her Ravenscar Dynasty series, which "Romantic Times" has called "her most exciting series yet." The series is loosely based on the reign of Henry VIII and his six wives. Bradford resets the story in the Edwardian era and depicts an unforgettable family battling over a worldwide business empire. In classic Bradford style, "The Heir" is a gripping tale of passion, power, family, and intrigue.
