## **Free Job Search Seminars at County Library**

St. Louis County Library presents a series of job search seminars with Al Hauser, Business Liaison for St. Louis Community College. The program is free and open to the public, and will be offered at 11 County Library Branches throughout 2008.

He works with businesses throughout the community to keep them informed of the services available through the MO Career Centers in St. Louis County and to provide opportunities for recruitment events and job fairs.

The Library has print and electronic resources to help with resumes and cover letters, careers and transitions, tips on the interview process, and research on specific companies and career fields.
