## Tax Help Available at Several County Library Branches

St. Louis County Library has resources available for those preparing state and federal taxes. Several branches will offer free help with federal and state tax returns with the assistance of various community groups. A list of the branches and the collaborating groups appears below.

All County Library branches have tax forms available either to download or photocopy. A fee of 10 cents per page is charged for photocopies and printouts. The library also has books with filing requirements and tax help.

St. Louis County Library does not have TurboTax. Similarly, because of privacy concerns, we do not advise using library computers to file taxes online.
