## St. Louis County Library and Left Bank Books Host Bestselling Fiction Writer Barbara Delinsky

The St. Louis County Library Foundation and Left Bank Books are pleased to present internationally bestselling author Barbara Delinsky for a discussion and signing of her latest novel “While My Sister Sleeps” on Wednesday, February 18, at 7:00 p.m. at Library Headquarters, 1640 S. Lindbergh Blvd. The program is free and open to the public.

Debbie Monterrey, co-host of KMOX 1120’s “Total Information AM,” will serve as the event’s Master of Ceremonies.

Following the success of “The Secret Between Us,” a book the “Boston Globe” hailed as “one of her best,” Barbara Delinsky returns with another moving and deeply satisfying novel, this one about the unique and emotionally complex world of siblings.

Sisters Molly and Robin Snow share a deep bond that sustains them through good times and bad. After Robin suffers a massive heart, Molly must face many difficult decisions as she uncovers secrets that threaten to destroy her understanding of the sister she thought she knew so well.
