# **Quick Start Guide**

## WHAT'S IN THE CASE

Chromebook	Hotspot
Power Adapter	USB Cord & Outlet Plug

## **BEFORE YOU START**

#### **Charge the Chromebook and Hotspot**

Using the provided charging cables for the Chromebook and Hotspot, it is recommended to fully charge the devices. Fully charging the Hotspot battery may take up to three hours.

# **GET CONNECTED**

#### **Power On the Hotspot**

Press and hold the power button for 3 seconds. It can take several minutes for the Hotspot to connect with the Mobile network.

#### Power Up the Chromebook

Lift the screen up and wait. It can take up to 15 seconds for the Chromebook to power on and cycle through to a web browser

#### **Connect Chromebook to Wi-Fi (Hotspot)**

- 1. In the bottom-right corner of the screen, click into the area with the Wi-Fi symbol
- 2. Click "Not connected" to turn on the Wi-Fi. A search for local networks will automatically begin.
- 3. Locate the label on the Hotspot as this information will have log-in credentials and contact information.
- **4.** Select the wireless network name as displayed on the Hotspot (SSID), click Connect, and enter the Wi-Fi password, also displayed on the Hotspot. It may take up to a minute to establish a connection.
- 5. Launch your device's web browser.

Note: Restart the device if having issues connecting to Wi-Fi.

<b>BUTTON OPERATION</b>	ACTIONS	
Power key	Press and hold the Power Key for 3 seconds to power the device on/off.	
Charging in USB port	Use the USB Type-C port to charge your Hotspot.	
Charging out USB port	Use the USB port to charge other devices, such as tablets and smartphones.
