### Activity

#### Indexing with FamilySearch.org

- ❖ Teachers can set-up a free account with Familysearch.org and select various indexing projects for students to learn and practice the process of indexing historical records.
- ❖ Indexing historical records helps students learn how to read and identify old handwriting and utilize inquiry skills to determine what information can be learned from various types of historical records and documents.
- ❖ Students will also become more familiar with primary sources and how historians can use and analyze them for learning about the past.

#### Instructions:

1. Go to FamilySearch.org to set-up a free account.
2. Once you are logged into your account, you can then click on **Indexing** to begin tutorials and find projects to index.
3. Click on Try it out, for an interactive, guided tour of the indexing process.

4. Click on Find a Project if you are ready to begin looking for indexing projects. You can search projects based on location, language, and difficulty.

The Help Resources Tab at the top of the Indexing page will open up a list of various resources for indexing. Select Indexer from the menu and you will see a list of resources for indexers. These resources include articles on how to get started, language and handwriting, tutorials, basic indexing guidelines, and FAQs.
